1. OPENING OF THE MEETING

Jay Pearlman, SG-OBPS Co-Chair, opened the meeting at 13.00 UTC on 08 July 2020. The online meeting was hosted by IODE using their GoTo Meeting subscription. Apologies were received from Adam Leadbetter, Kirsten Isensee, Frank Muller-Karger and Emma Heslop. A complete list of the meeting participants is shown in Annex I.

The meeting agenda had been provided online in GDrive one week before the meeting and Work Package(WP) leads had contributed topics they wished to report or discuss. A draft version of this meeting report will be provided to participants to give them the opportunity to provide any additional brief text for inclusion.

2. REVIEW OF ACTION ITEMS FROM SG-OBPS MONTHLY MEETING - 20200610

A review of action items from the previous meeting was conducted. Any outstanding actions from that list are now contained in Annex III. Incomplete actions were requested to be progressed by Pauline Simpson Project Manager OBPS. 3. WORK PACKAGES DISCUSSION TOPICS

3.1 WP1: PROJECT MANAGEMENT

Pauline Simpson reported:

- 1. **SG-OBPS second annual meeting** will be held during the week of 19-23 October 2020. A virtual environment calls for different planning to a face-to-face and a Doodle poll had been sent to SG to ascertain what date/time next week when most of SG would be available to discuss such planning topics as sessions times, time zones, agenda etc.
- 2. **OBPS Official Name**: Following an action item last month, Pauline Simpson had referred to the IOC Decision in 2019 and also confirmed with Peter Pissienssen, Head of the UNESCO/IOC Project Office for IODE that the official name to be used in documentation is **IOC Ocean Best Practices System (OBPS)**
- 3. OBPS Workshop IV update: Jay Pearlman reported that 'Save the Date' and 'Invitation to Working Group(WG) Leads' including a preliminary agenda had been sent out this week. The Early Career Ocean Professionals (ECOP) Call, also sent out, was discussed and it was agreed there would be two routes for ECOPS participants to be a workshop colead 1. via the general ECOP Call and 2. by personal invitation from the WG Lead. It was noted there was an issue with the web site contact form.
 ACTION: Arno Lambert to resolve the website contact form not forwarding asap

4. Email overload: The general feeling in SG is that there is an email overload for OBPS. Whilst we want to engender inclusivity, it was recommended that more care be taken on including all the SG in all mailings. Slack has been suggested as a communication tool

and whilst some are enthusiastic others do not want 'yet another email system to check'. An Ocean Best Practices System Slack channel and other topic channels have been set up to allow SG members to experience Slack.

ACTION: Create a task group to recommend a solution to the email overload - Johannes Karstensen/Juliet Hermes/Pauline Simpson/Mark Bushnell/Francoise Pearlman/Pier Luig Buttigieg/Cora Horstmann.

ACTION: Juliet Hermes recommended to set up a Slack channel for the task group

5. External Projects. Citing the example of the proposed INTAROS-2 Project, Jay Pearlman seconded by Pauline Simpson, raised the necessity for a procedure to be agreed by the SG when there were opportunities for OBPS to be involved in external projects. There have been instances where the SG were only informed of OBPS inclusion in a project after it was signed, so all new project proposals which require OBPS contributions should be submitted to the OBPS Steering Group for approval, to assess its relevance to OBPS objectives and how it will contribute resources to the OBPS activities. There were opposing opinions on the benefits and disbenefits of OBPS involvement as a project partner in external projects. Discussion on the INTAROS-2 proposal is in progress..
ACTION: Create a task group to develop a process for dealing with external project proposals: Pauline Simpson/Johannes Karstense/Jay Pearlman/Cristian Munoz (Emma Heslop/Peter Pissierssens for UNESCO admin advice). The two WP3 co-leads were unable to attend so the agenda items will be included in the August monthly meeting



- 3. AIR Centre Network Presentation: Jay Pearlman reported that he would be presenting about ocean best practices at one of these Networking Friday online meetings on August 12.. He requested ideas for success stories.

3.4. WP6: USER COMMUNITIES

1. **Community Forum:** Mark Bushnell (co-lead WP6) welcomed the addition of Nicholas Roden and Raïssa Meyer as forum administrators. The Forum interface has now been branded for OBPS. The forum had been announced in the OBPS Newsletter and IOOS Eyes on the Ocean bi-weekly, and by email to the ecosystems mooring community leaders. Emily Smail GEO Blue Planet - Sargassum management has been invited to use the forum. 2. **Decade:** Under this WP6 Frank Muller-Karger is leading the activity. It has been confirmed by Peter Pissierssens and the UN Decade office that the IOC Ocean Best Practices System is a UN entity under the Endorsement of Decade Actions. There will be a meeting called to discuss comments on Version 1.0 of the Implementation Plan and Katherina Schoo confirmed that OBPS SG would be among those invited . There have



been many applications from organizations, networks etc but an list for Decade Actions is not accessible. Jay Pearlman suggested putting together a list of these proposals we are aware of as well as their leads and Juliet Hermes asked to ensure they are invited to the OBPS Workshop IV Decade session.

ACTION: Create a task group for Decade/OBPS - initially Frank Muller-Karger, Johannes Karstensen and Juliet Hermes.

ACTION: Create a list of Decade Action Application leads and invite to the workshop IV -Frank Muller-Karger

3.5. WP7: CAPACITY DEVELOPMENT AND TRAINING

1. Capacity Development Survey: Claudia Delgado and Ana Lara Lopez (co-leads WP7) confirmed that there had been 62 responses to the survey and that analysis of results would be presented at the September Monthly Meeting.

- IODE XXVI: Peter Pissierssens reminded that the SG would need to prepare a report for the IODE Committee; which should include a strategic component, how OBPS collaborates with other projects and programmes; a work plan with required resources (IOC + additional) for the next 2 + years. It will then go to the IOC Assembly. This will be discussed at SG-OBPS-2 with input from the OBPS Workshop IV ACTION: Prepare a Report for IODEXXVI and IOC Assembly to be submitted to IODE by November 2020
