Subject: Invitation to the rescheduled 53rd session of the IOC Executive Council to be conducted online from 1 to 9 February 2021

This circular letter complements the consultations conducted by the IOC Chairperson Mr Ariel H. Troisi with Member States through circular letters 2799, 2813 and 2818. It provides technical guidance for the 53<sup>rd</sup> Session of IOC Executive Council (EC-53), the first on-line session of an IOC Governing Body. The session of EC-53 will be preceded by the Officers meeting on 1 February and the Intersessional Financial Advisory Group (IFAG) on 2 February. The plenary session will open at 1 p.m. CET on 3 February 2021. Conducting the session successfully is a major technical and organizational challenge, but I still very much look forward to it as a source of so much needed Member States' guidance to steer the work of the Secretariat on key issues of IOC portfolio.

Member States of the IOC Executive Council (EC) and observers are invited to urgently notify the secretariat (p.boned@unesco.org and v.ryabinin@unesco.org) of the composition of their delegation. Please clearly state the designated Head of Delegation, and possibly one Alternate and indicate official email addresses of the Head of Delegation and Alternate to be used for their online connection.

The platform for your remote participation in all meetings of EC-53 will be Zoom. There will be three types of meetings: (i) the plenary session; (ii) the IFAG & Financial Committee; and (iii) the Resolutions Committee.

The document introduces the Draft Resolution on the UN Decade of Ocean Science for Sustainable Development and a small change to the previously published Draft Resolution on Governance, Programming and Budgeting Matters of the Commission (this corrected version has already been circulated to IFAG) and the proposed Chairperson of the Resolutions Committee.

I would also like to invite you to attend the **high-level online event 'A Brave New Ocean'** to celebrate the start of the Ocean Decade. It will take place on 3 February at 16.15 CET, after the end of the plenary session. Video interventions and live panel discussions will involve global leaders from governments, the world of philanthropy, UN agencies and some prominent marine scientists. The link to the event will be shared with all Member States and partners at the end of January.

The IOC Secretariat looks forward to welcoming you to the online 53<sup>rd</sup> Session of IOC Executive Council. I thank you for your understanding of the exceptional nature of this session, and I hope that the constructive spirit of our prior consultations and work during this past year, under the difficult circumstances, will continue to prevail and help us to successfully conduct EC-53.
