Recommendations of the 13th Session of the ICG/IOTWMS related to the Working Group 3



- The ICG decided to establish Tsunami Ready Focal Points (TRFPs) nominated by each Member State to enhance communication, coordination, and implementation of the TRRP or similar initiatives across the Indian Ocean.
- Encouraged all Member States to consider implementing the Tsunami Ready Recognition Programme (TRRP) for vulnerable communities leading to IOC-UNESCO recognition.
- To again undertake a full Capacity Assessment of Tsunami Preparedness in the Indian Ocean in 2024 to evaluate progress of the IOTWMS since the Indian Ocean Tsunami of 2004, and also undertake a shorter assessment before each session of the ICG for review by Member States through an online questionnaire to continuously monitor progress after each intersessional period to help guide the work plans of the ICG/IOTWMS.


