INTRODUCTION



(Fiji seismicity from 1986 – 2015, MRD)

Fiji is located at the midpoint of the potential tsunami sources, the Tonga trench and the New Hebrides trench.

• 1953: A 6.7M earthquake hit Fiji causing a tsunami along its coastlines.

 The seismology section monitors all seismic activities and potential

tsunami threats to the Fiji region.

SEISMOLOGY SECTION

- 24/7 monitoring of earthquakes and tsunamis
- Currently 8 seismic stations transmitting real time data to our Suva hub.
- Waveforms are analyzed in software's such as Seiscomp and Swarms
- The Fiji Network shares data with other SW Pacific countries through the Oceania Regional Seismic Network (ORSNET) which also contributes in our monitoring capabilities.

NDMO TO CONDUCT LIVE TSUNAMI SIREN TEST

The National Disaster Management Office (NDMO) wishes to advise the public that we will be conducting a **live tsunami siren test** for the **Suva – Lami corridor** at **11am**, **Monday 06th December**, **2021**.

This exercise is part of Government's continued commitment towards improving its state of readiness for any tsunami event. The purpose of this siren test is to test the functionality of the sirens.

There are a total of 13 sirens installed along the Suva foreshore, having an acoustic range of 1.2kms.

Locations of the sirens are as follows:

1. Water Authority of Fiji – Kinoya Sewerage Plant 2. FINTEL – Vatuwaqa 3. RFMF Officers Training School – Vatuwaqa 4. USP Statham 5. USP Lower Campus 6. USP Main campus 7. My Suva Park 8. Government Training Centre – Nasese 9. I-Taukei Trust Fund Board 10. SCC Crvic Car park Rooftop 11. Biosecurity, Renown Street – Suva Central 12. Government Shipping Services – Walu Bay 13. Lami Town

ALL THIRTEEN (13) TSUNAMI SIRENS WILL BE ACTIVATED. However, NO EVACUATION is REQUIRED.
