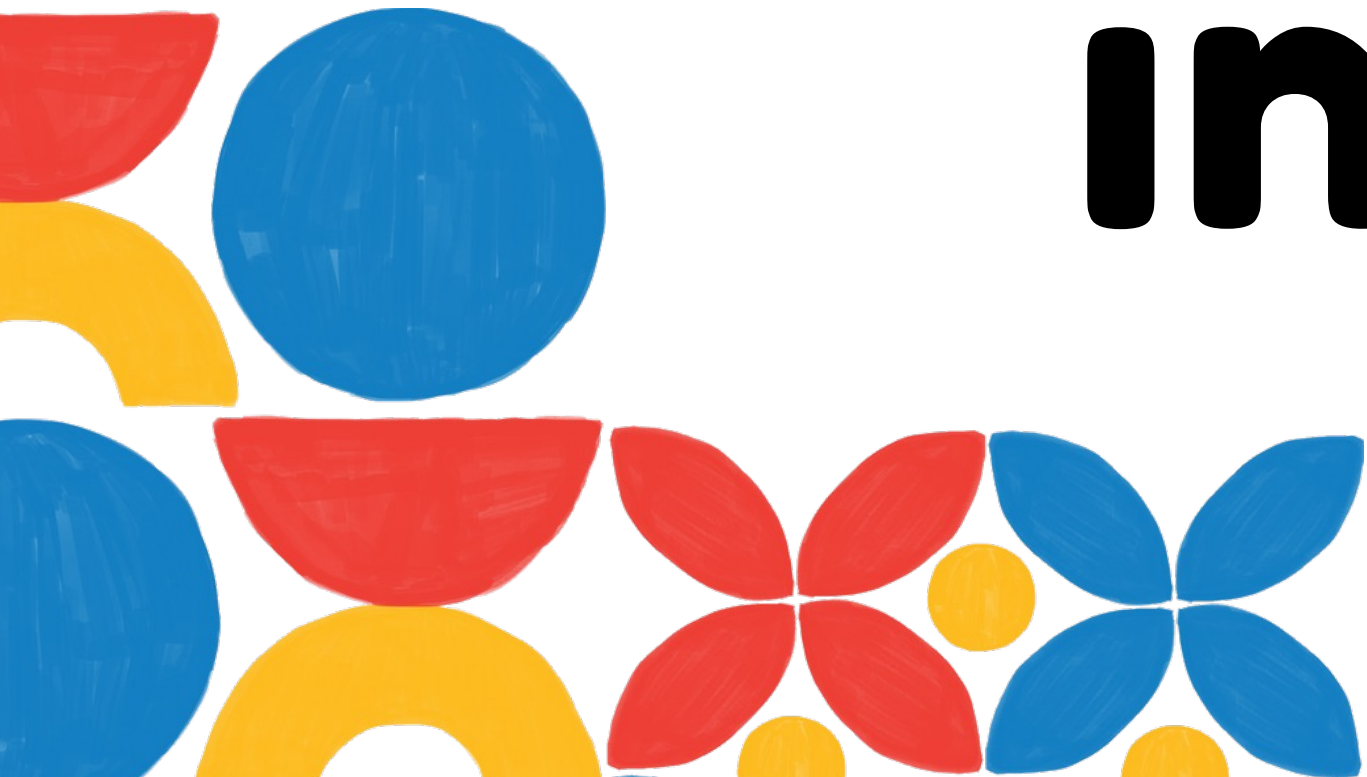

How to upload original designs in Canva

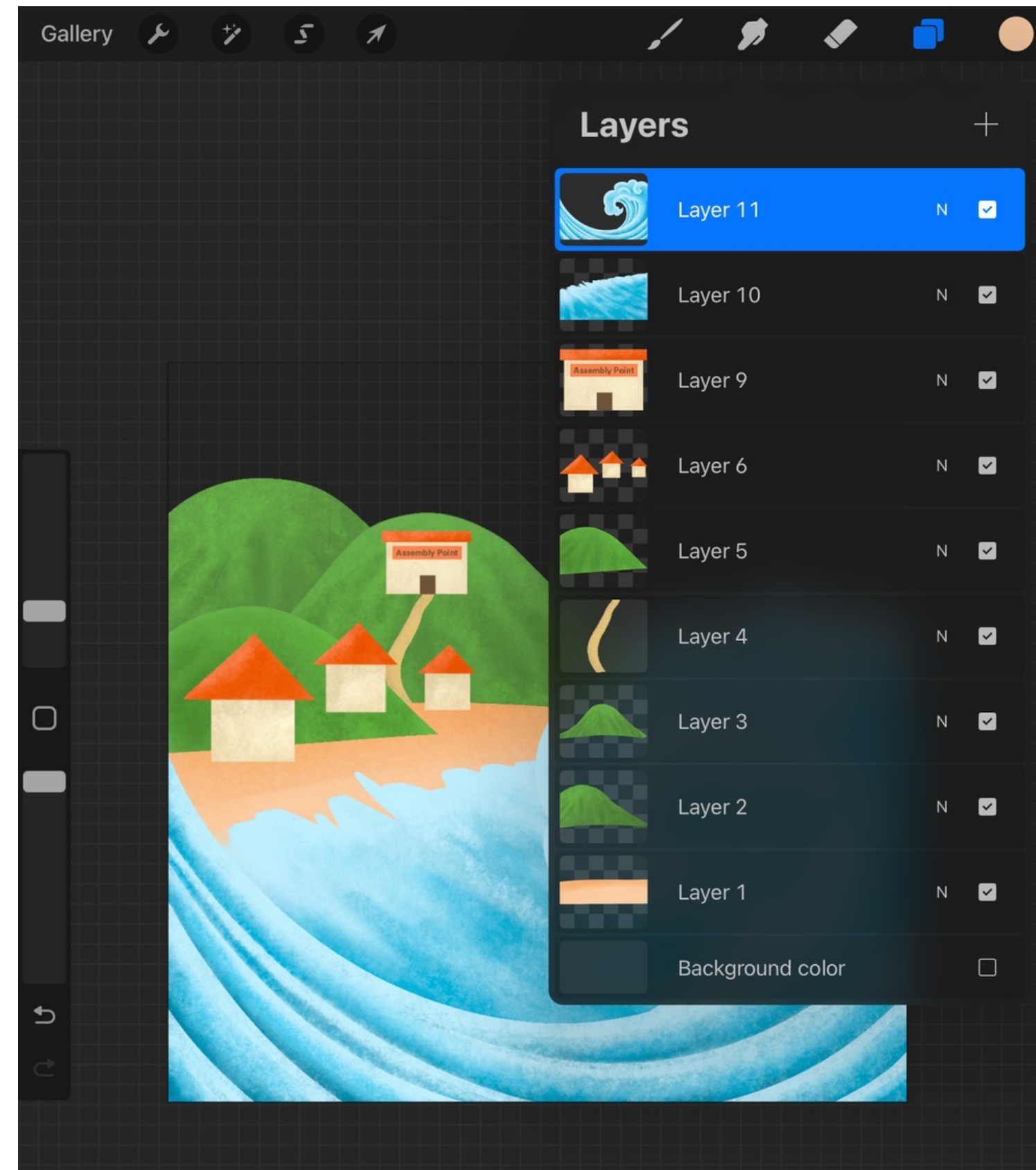


Step 1: Select your illustration app of choice!



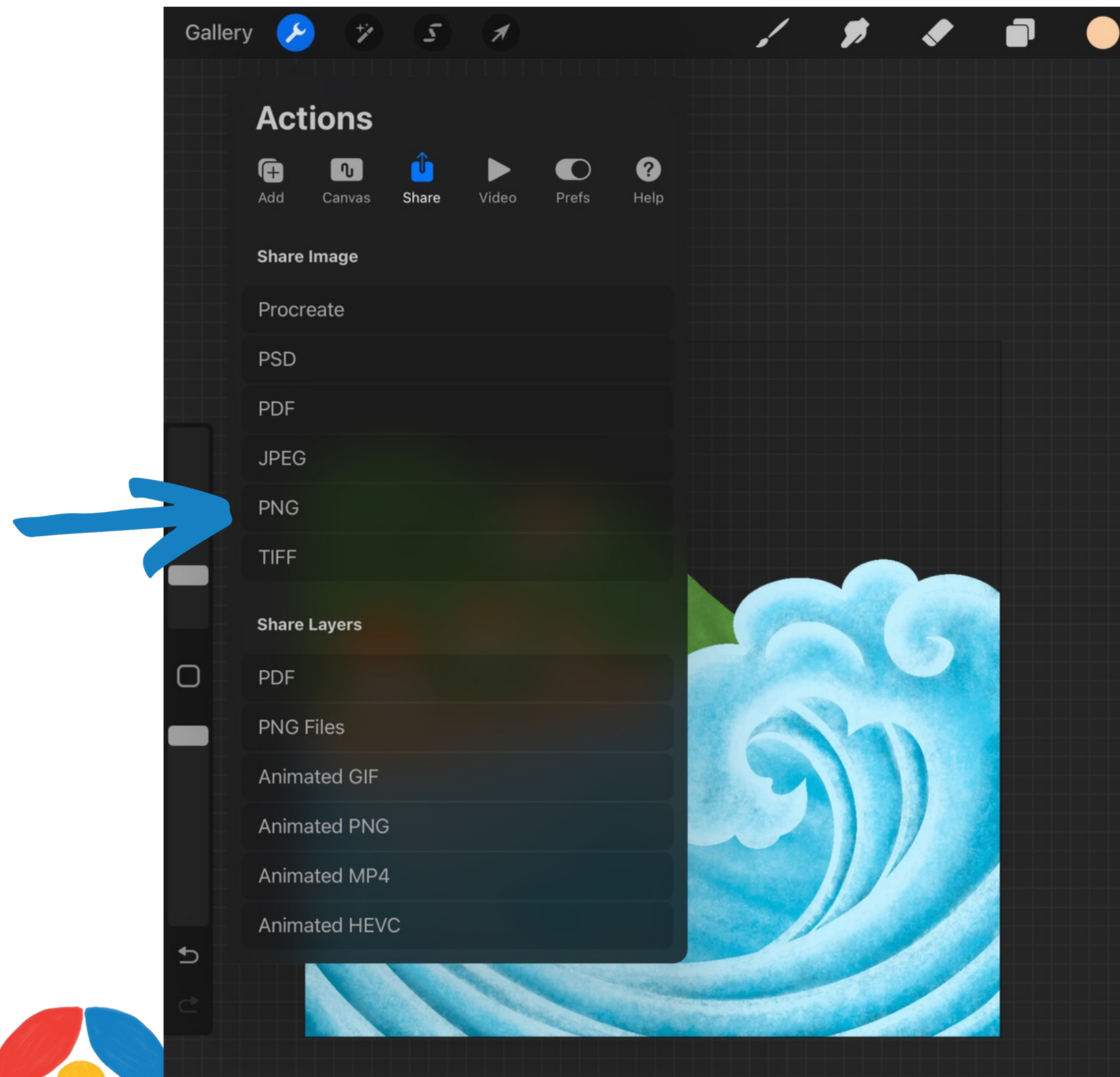
These are all examples of illustration apps, but there are many more mediums that get the job done. Find an app that works for you and start creating!

Suggestion: Create each element in separate layers so that you may use it individually if desired



Note: The app being used is Procreate

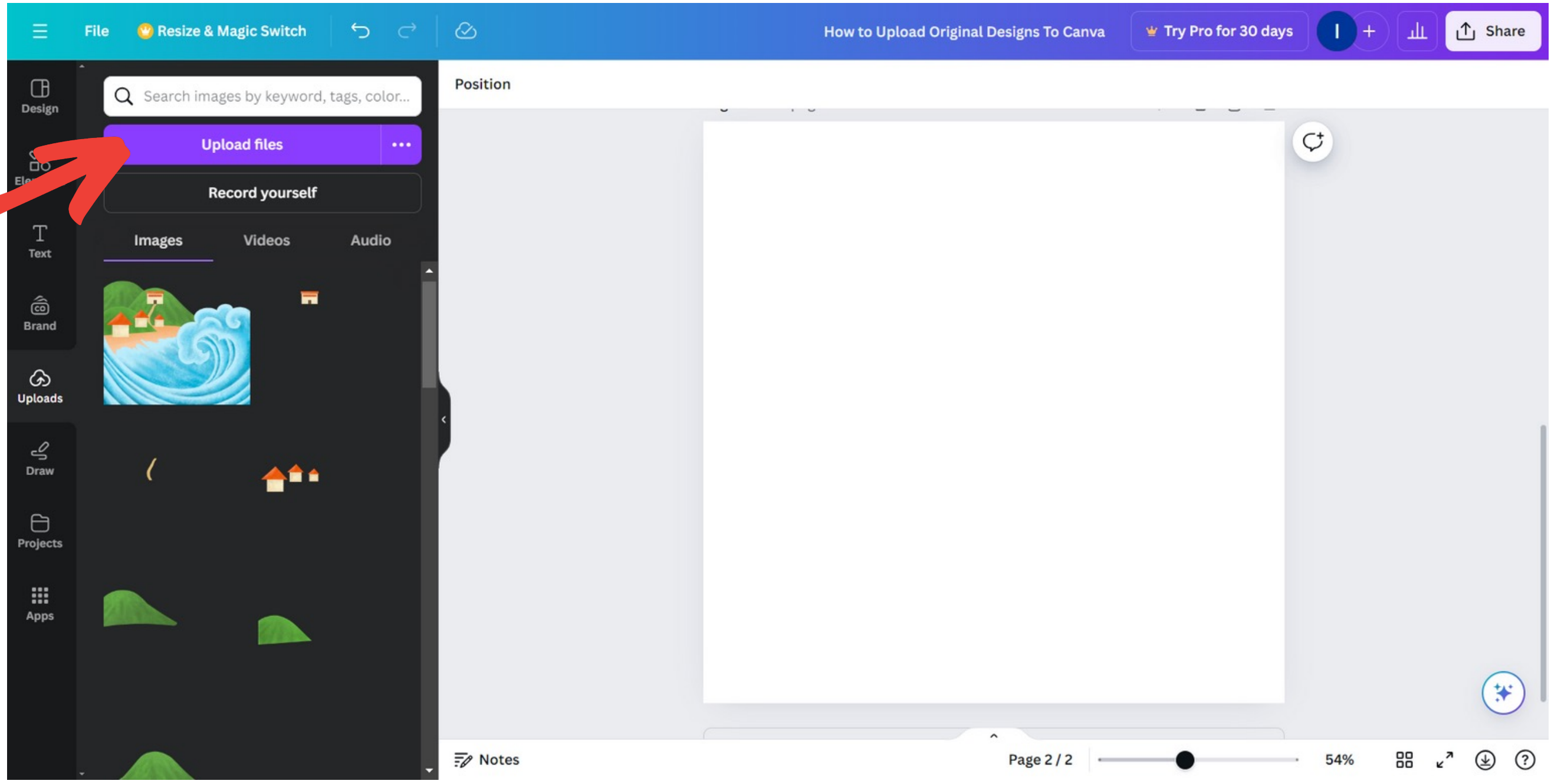
Step 2: Save your design as PNG



PNG files allow us to maintain the quality of our works without it decaying each time we save or edit an illustration

Step 3: Upload your design to Canva

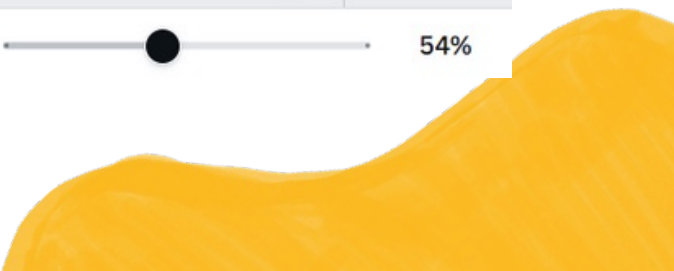
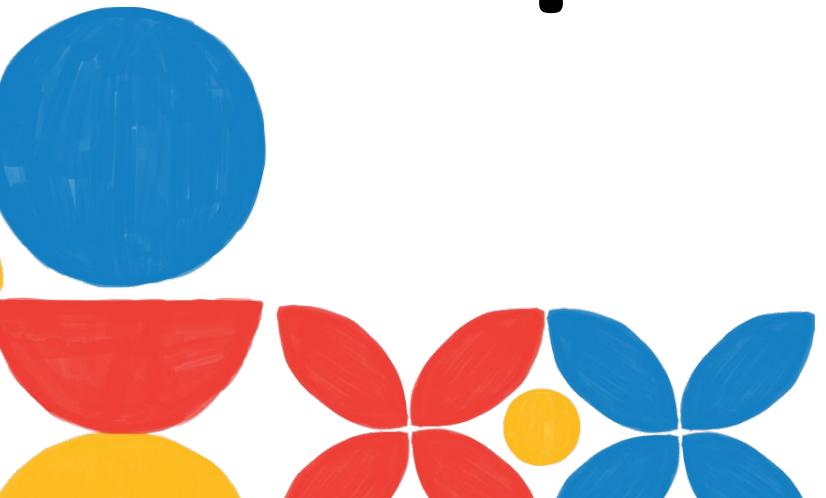
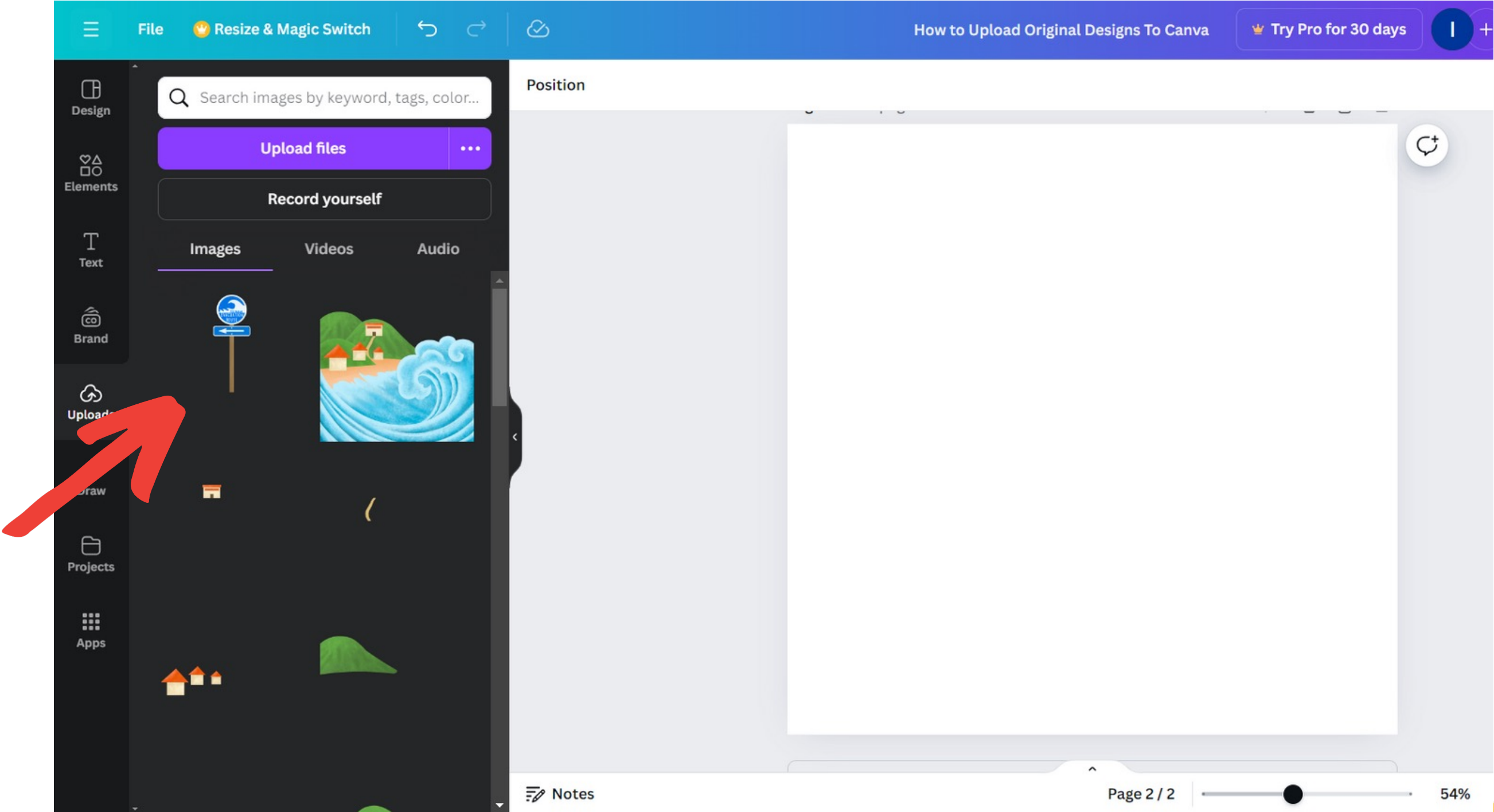

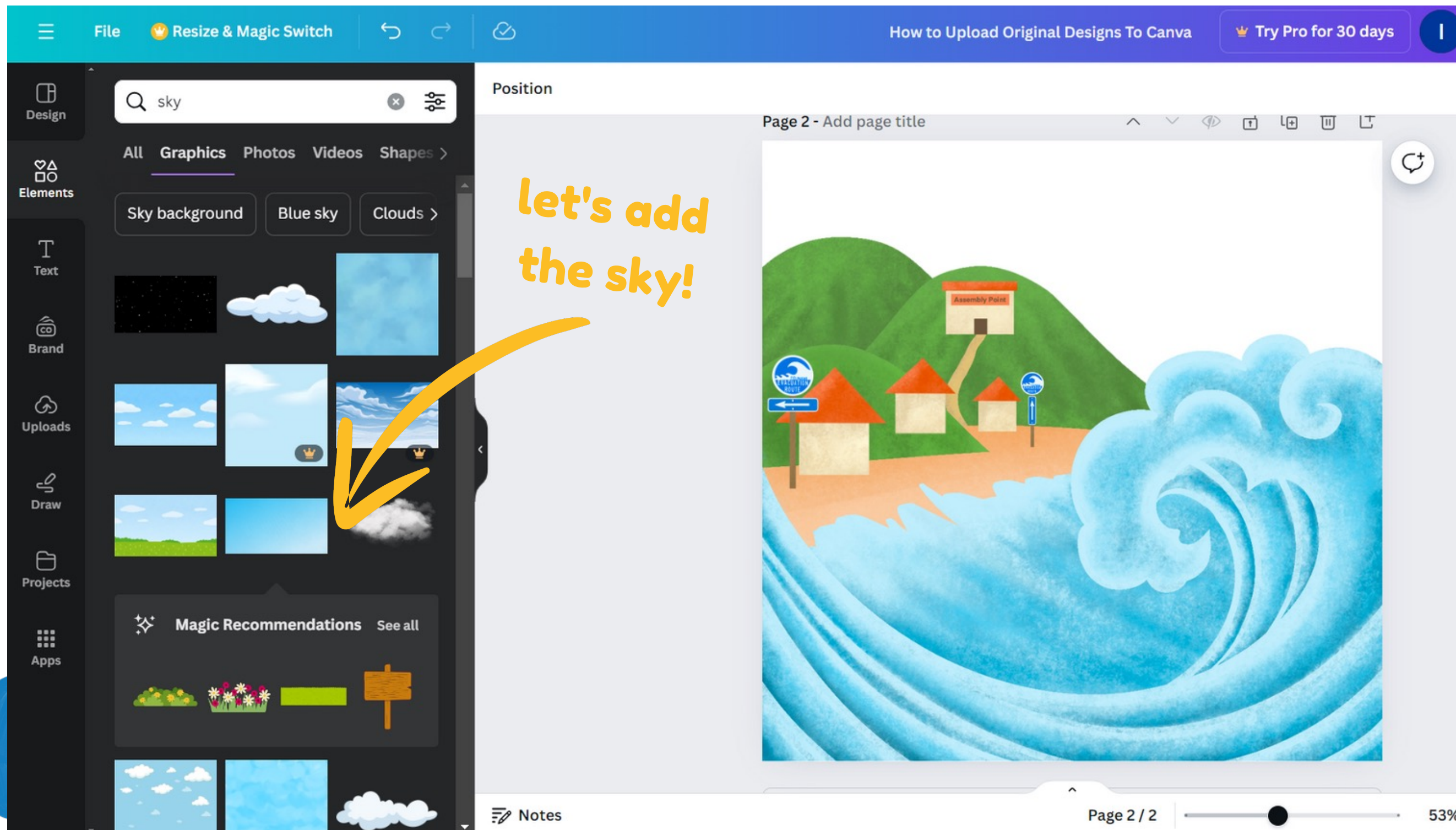
Step 4: Fill your canvas!



By adding elements, you can create different landscapes!



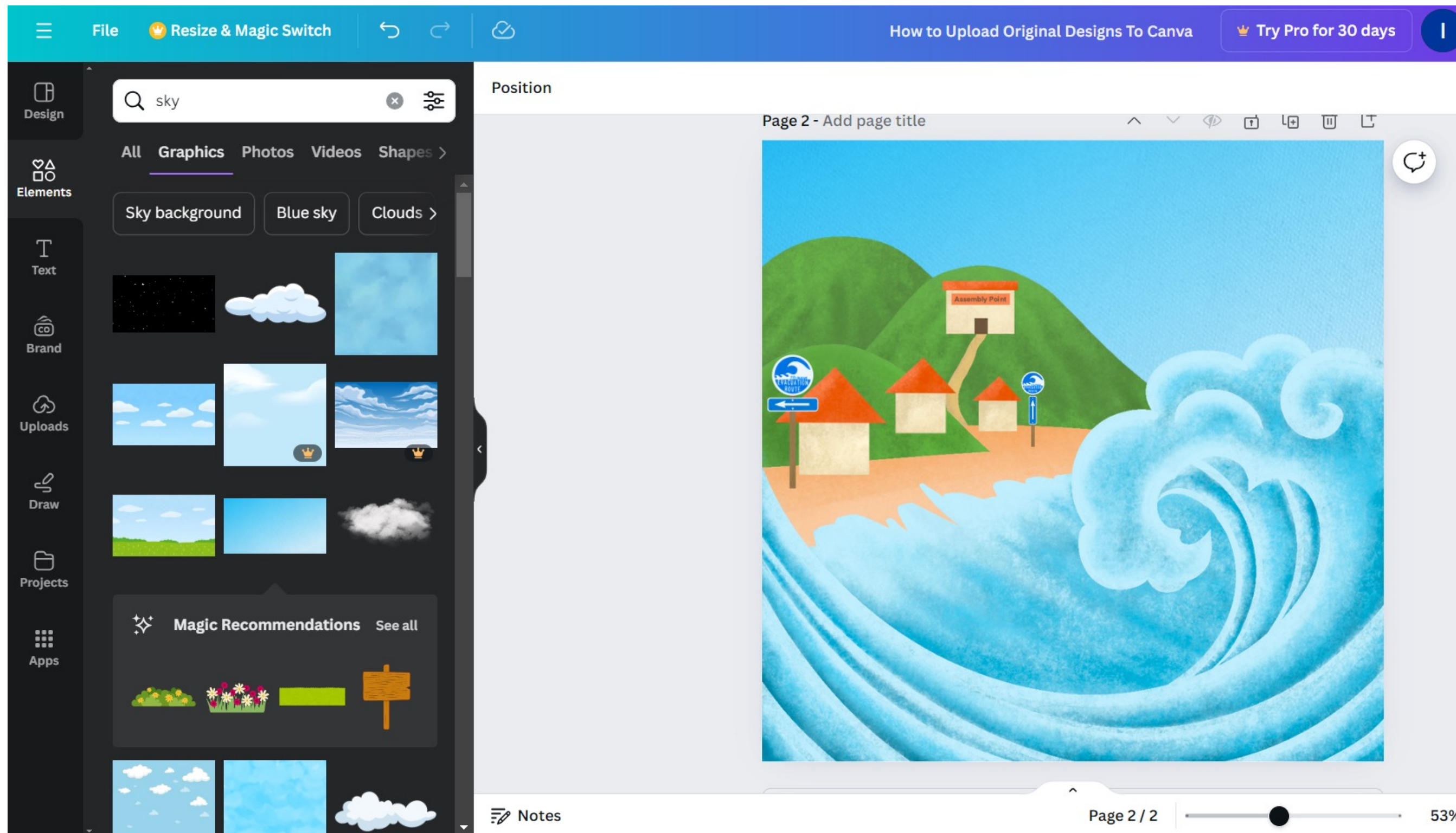

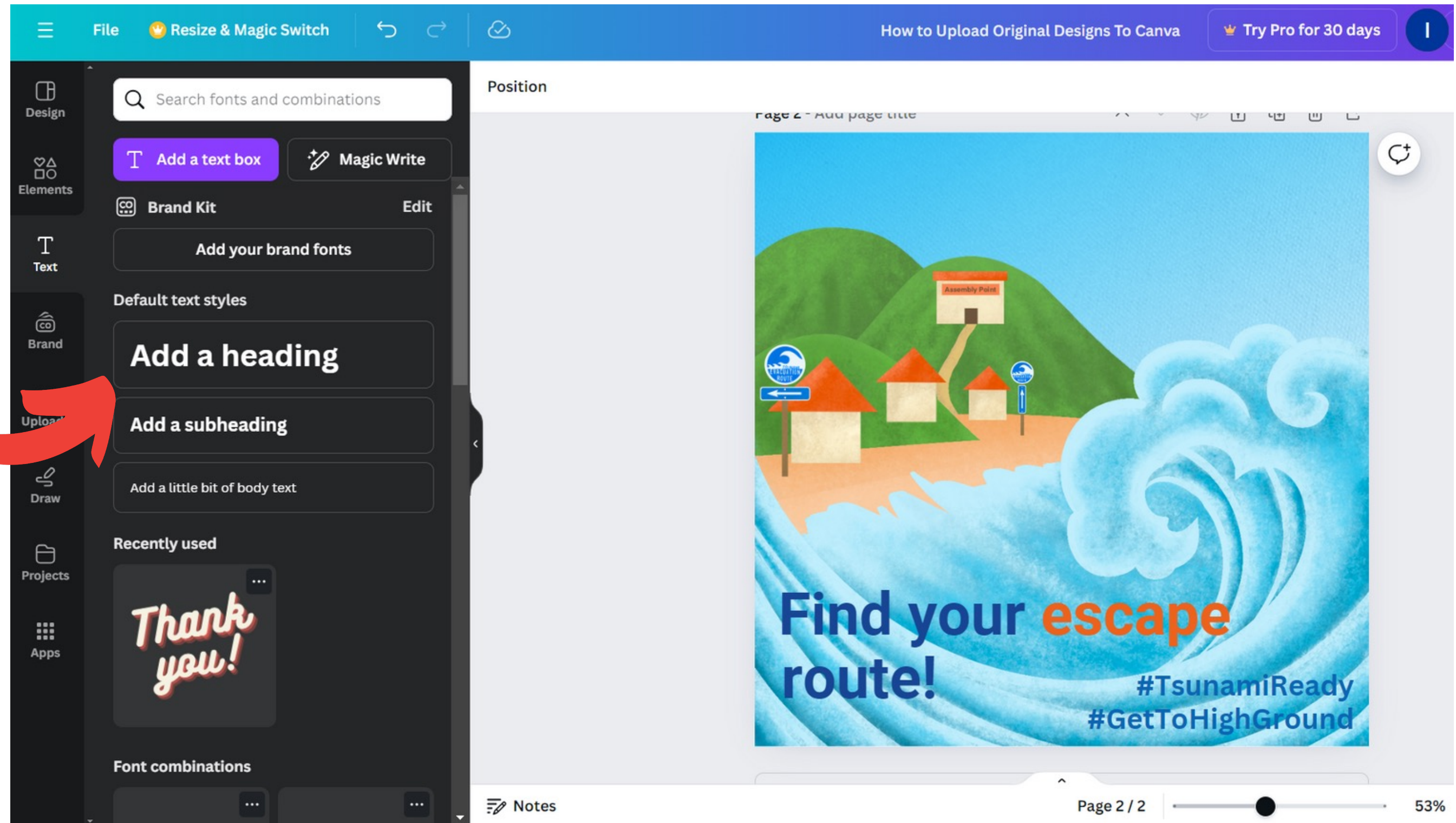
