




## Create a Canva account

- Every time you work in Canva, log in with your account.




## Getting to know what you can do in Canva

Decide what you want to do: Facebook post, Presentation, Instagram post, Business card...




# Creating your design from scratch...

- A whole lot of templates will appear underneath your search selection



#### Click on your favorite template and it will show automatically You can always go back using the back button, choose another template over and over...



#### Side bar menu


- Every icon is customizable

Text- headings, styles, fonts, additional texts


Uploads- upload photos, videos, charts from your computer, Cloud, Drive...

Choose your favorite font, text size, colors, add effects, animations, position any object






